GRIEVANCE AND ARBITRATION PROCEDURE

Collective Bargaining Agreement - Article IX, Paragraph 904, Page 10

Association grievances filed on behalf of a group of Health Care Professionals in more than one (1) affiliate will be filed directly at Step Three by an Association State Officer or Staff Representative within thirty (30) calendar days after the Association had knowledge, or should have had knowledge, of the event which caused the grievance or complaint.

UNAC/ UHCP has filed four (4) regional grievances in the past four months related to contract violations, working conditions, patient safety and risk to RN license.

Message Management

Subject: Excessive Workload, lack of replacement staff and backfill for message management, multiple distractions effecting efficiencies and patient safety.

Volunteering to Work without pay

Subject: Employees worked on day off without pay while performing job description/duties that they normally perform. This volunteer/community benefit program was implemented without Union involvement.

Verbal Orders

Subject: Excessive use of verbal orders in the workplace resulting in disciplines, risk to patient safety and RN license. Go to unacuhcp.org/verbalorders to sign the petition protesting verbal orders given inappropriately.

Home Health/Hospice Workload

Failure to implement the Issue Resolution Agreements of 2001, excessive workload, denial of OT, failure to properly train and support the Health Connect Rollout.
