

UNAC/UHCP Bargaining Update #1

National negotiations with Kaiser began on Tuesday, March 6th. Our union is negotiating along with 26 other unions that make up the Coalition of Kaiser Permanente Unions. Collectively we represent 95,000 Kaiser workers across the country, including nearly 14,000 UNAC/UHCP members from all over Southern California.

We spent the initial three sessions on training the bargaining team members on bargaining strategy and approach. On the Thursday management and the Unions broke into five sub-groups:

- Enhancing the Partnership
- Growth of KP and Unions
- Total Health
- Workforce of the Future

In these sub groups we began the process of identifying our key interests and priorities for each of these areas.
