# Did You Know? 2013 UNAC/UHCP Scholarship Programs

The UNAC/UHCP <u>Member Scholarship Program</u> is an ongoing program of scholarships available to full dues-paying UNAC/UHCP members to continue their education in the health care field. Eight scholarships of \$2,500 each are awarded annually to the winners selected from applicants who meet the eligibility requirements and submit complete applications.

The UNAC/UHCP <u>Family Scholarship Program</u> is an ongoing program of scholarships available to the spouses, registered domestic partners, and dependent children (as defined by the U.S. Internal Revenue Service) of full dues-paying UNAC/UHCP members. Five scholarships of \$2,000 each are awarded annually to the winners selected from applicants who meet the eligibility requirements and submit complete applications.

The UNAC/UHCP <u>Community Scholarship Program</u> is an ongoing program of scholarships available to students seeking health care professional degrees at an accredited institution located in Southern California. Five scholarships of \$1,000 each are awarded annually to the winners selected from applicants who meet the eligibility requirements and submit complete applications.
