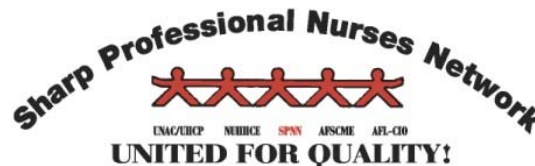
In June several MICU RNs filed a complaint regarding a Lead
